**FEDERAL SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY GRANT (FSEOG) PROGRAM
SELECTION POLICY**

The Federal Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant is a Campus-Based grant program available to undergraduate students. Awards, when available, can range from \$100 to \$4,000 for a full academic year.

FSEOG is awarded to eligible students who demonstrate financial need as calculated in the student's packaging. Students who are PELL eligible with the lowest Expected Family Contribution (EFC) are the first students selected as FSEOG recipients, and are part of the FSEOG first selection group.

A student who receives PELL at any time during the award year may be awarded FSEOG, even if the PELL was not received in the same payment period as the FSEOG. For example, a student who only receives a Pell Grant for the fall semester, due to reaching lifetime eligibility used (LEU), the student may be awarded FSEOG for both the fall semester and subsequent spring semester.

If FSEOG funds remain available after all PELL eligible recipients have been awarded, students with the lowest EFC's who are not receiving PELL grants and have demonstrated financial need as calculated in the student's packaging are selected and are part of the FSEOG second selection group. This group would also include students who have exceeded their LEU.
